

COVID-19 Vaccination Policy for Visitors, Suppliers, Contractors and Service providers

6th December 2021

At Summerland, we have a responsibility to always safeguard our employees, as well as other Summerland stakeholders (including but not limited to; customers, suppliers, transport sub-contractors, third-party transporters, our contractors, and other approved visitors), from infectious diseases.

We need to ensure that our depots and operational areas remain 'safe havens' that provide protection against life-threatening viruses such as COVID-19, to do all that we possibly can to keep people safe and continue to perform the essential services we provide of transporting amongst other things, food, beverages, and groceries across the South Island.

Summerland Express Freight has completed a risk assessment in conjunction with WorkSafe guidelines on how best to protect our employees. Based on Government guidance and expert health advice, vaccination is the safest and most effective protection against COVID-19.

From the 6th of December 2021, all suppliers, service providers and other visitors to Summerland's sites must be able to provide evidence of being fully vaccinated against COVID-19. Those who are not vaccinated or who aren't able to provide evidence of vaccination will not be allowed to enter the premises.

We will accept the following as evidence of vaccination:

- A screenshot of your "My COVID Record" vaccination details from <https://app.covid19.health.nz/>
- A screenshot from your primary health provider's online patient information system, (Manage my health, Indici, ConnectMed, etc)
- A scan of your vaccination wallet card
- A screenshot of My Vaccine Pass
- Validated scan of the My Vaccine Pass QR code using NZ Pass Verifier app at one of our sites
- A printed Vaccine Pass

Your vaccination records are considered personal medical information and Summerland will only use these records to validate vaccination status. They will not be stored by us.

We also acknowledge that there are some people who are currently uncertain about vaccination, do not wish to get vaccinated, or are not able to get vaccinated for medical reasons. If so, our teams will be happy to arrange for contact via video call, phone, or email.
